ORDINANCE #11  
NO PARKING ORDINANCE

An ordinance establishing no parking areas in Gladwin County, Butman Township, Michigan.

Section I DEFINITIONS:

- A. This ordinance shall be known as the "no parking ordinance" in its short form.
- B. For the purpose of the ordinance the following terms shall have the following meaning.

Parking: The stopping of a motor vehicle (as defined by the Michigan Motor Vehicle code and its amendments) in designated "no parking" areas.

Section II ENABLING AUTHORITY

This ordinance is a recognition of the township government's responsibility in protecting the health and safety of its citizens. Further, this ordinance is adopted pursuant to Act No. 246 of Public Acts of 1945, and amendments thereto being sections 41.181 to 41.183 and act No. 191 of Public Acts of 139, and amendments thereto, being Sections 41.191 to Sections 41.192 of compiled laws.

Section III VIOLATIONS

It shall be unlawful:

- 1. To park at any time within the right of way on either side of Hockaday road, from point 1200 feet norther and south of the centerline of the bridge, spanning Lake Lancer.
- 2. To park at any time within the right of way on Grass Lake Road, from point 500 feet east of the center line of Hockaday Road.

3. To park at any time within the right of way on Preston Drive from a point 500 feet west of the center line of Hockaday Road
4. To park at any time within the right of way on Manchester Way from a point 500 feet west of the center line of Hockaday Road.
5. To park at any time within the right of way on Stirling Circle east of Hockaday Road.
6. To park at any time within the right of way on Islanders Way between a point south of Winchester Way and the cul-de-sac west of Middlehaven Drive.
7. To park at any time within the right of way on either side of Butman Road from a point south of the DNR Properties to Hamilton Way. Surrey Court and the Butman Township Sanitary Sewer lift Station #12, are also designated no parking at any time, within their respective right of ways.
8. To park at any time within the right of way of the access drive and boat launch facility, of the Butman Township Launch, Lake Lancer. Parking in designated parking spaces is by approved permit display only. Any vehicle that is parked other than in a designated parking spot, will be towed away, at the owners expense. Furthermore there is no overnight parking allowed. Parking is allowed between the hours of 5:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., so long as all permit requirements have been met.
9. To park at any time within the driveways and parking spaces of the Butman Township Hall and Butman Township Department of Public Works, with a designated Boat Launch Vehicle. These areas are also designated tow away zones, at owners expense.

#### Section IV PENALTIES

Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or imprisonment in the County Jail not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

## Section V VALIDITY OF ORDINANCE

Should any section, sentence, clause, phrase, portion or provision of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional by court of competent jurisdiction, such section, sentence, clause, phrase, portion or provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of remaining portions of such section of this ordinance or any part there of other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional

## Section VI EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days from publication hereof.
