

Ordinance #30A

Establish Rules for the Usage of the Butman Township Camera

WHEREAS BE IT RESOLVED THAT the camera will be available only to contractors working on the sewer connections within Butman Township. It will not be made available to contractors for usage outside Butman Township.

WHEREAS BE IT RESOLVED the identifying the lot to be staked is the responsibility of the lot owner, builder and or contractor. Butman Township/United Water does not accept any liability in identifying lots.

WHEREAS BE IT RESOLVED that a contractor has applied for a Construction Permit and also acknowledges that a Corporate Surety Bond in the sum of \$10,000.00 is on file with Butman Township. All work must be performed in accordance with **Butman Township Sewer Ordinances** and in compliance with existing MIOSHA Safety and Health Standards. A County Plumbing Permit must be obtained and approved.

The following rules and regulations, without exception, must be followed:

- Lot staking request will be completed by the third (3rd) work day
- Sewer installs only on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday.
- No sewer connections are to start after 10:00 am.
- Sewers not completed by 3:30 pm will be scheduled for the next available day.
- No sewers scheduled for the day before a holiday.
- The depth dug shall be according to the blueprint of the depth of the downstream manhole.
- Sewer tap plug, (cover) are not to be removed nor shall any pipe be installed until the Inspector is on sight and gives the approval.
- Necessary equipment shall be on site before the tap cover is removed: fernco, pipe, sand etc.
- The use of outside cameras by contractors are not allowed in Butman Township.

- If the contractor still cannot locate the sewer connection after permits have been filed, excavation has been made according to the blueprints including the depth of the downstream manhole, then the contractor may call United Water for assistance. The availability of United Water manpower and equipment will be prioritized and based on emergency calls and routine service to Butman Township.
